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Property Fire Insurance – Sturgeon County residents may qualify for reduced fire insurance rates.

Sturgeon County's Protective Services has been accredited by the Fire Underwriters Survey to provide Superior Tanker Shuttle Services (STSS). All of the County's Fire Districts (Namao, Calahoo, Morinville, Legal, Bon Accord Gibbons & Redwater Fire Stations) have been added to the list of accredited agencies for delivery of the STSS. Sturgeon County is the second municipality in the province to have this accreditation.

What does this mean for you? Residents within the Districts who own detached dwellings, are within 8 KM of an accredited fire hall & 5 km of a water supply point may be eligible to receive an improved Fire Insurance Grade. Sturgeon County recommends that you contact your insurance agent directly and review your current Property Fire Insurance ratings. If your insurance company does not apply the STSS Accreditation, please explore options by obtaining quotes from other companies.
