FROM THE EXECUTIVE:


Our last executive meeting took place on October 6th, 2020. The following items were discussed.

1. Our 2020 AGM was postponed due to COVID, but we are mandated to have one each year so it has been set for 7:30 pm on November 24 at Cardiff Hall. It will be arranged with social distancing and all attendees will be asked to wear a mask if able. We do need 16 attendees to meet our quorum, so if you can be there we would appreciate it.
2. Scott Fuhr will once again be coordinating the rink preparation and ice upkeep. As always, if you can help, please contact him directly; 780-910-1486. Note that based on AHS guidelines we may not be able to have the skate shack open or if we do there will be signage reminding people to physical distance and/or a maximum number allowed inside. We will make decisions based on the guidelines at the time that ice is ready to be used.
3. Inspection of fire alarm and fire suppression system was done in September. We need to replace three extinguishers and would like to thank **Toms & Le Wealth Management Group** for purchasing these and donating them to CCA.
4. We received our food handling permit for the upcoming year.
5. Discussed hall rental rate for community programs offered by Sturgeon County. Executive felt it was important to keep these programs in our community and are offering a rate that would cover expenses with no profit. Sturgeon County Community Services has accepted this offer and will continue to offer the programs at Cardiff Hall.
